Elmer Breeden Tops City Rankings for 1971-72

The Washington City Tenpin Bowling Association released its official rankings for the 1971-72 season last month.

The big surprise was the takeover of the first place spot by Elmer Breeden of Manassas, ousting Jim Robinette who has had a lock on the Number One ranking for five consecutive years.

Breeden edged Robinette by .683 of a percentage point. His average, based on both league and tournament bowling, was 199.062. Robinette came in with a second place average of 198.379.

The list of the top 20 area bowlers from last season is published below.



In order to be considered for ranking, a bowler must roll a minimum of 210 games consisting of 160 league games and 20 tournament games, plus an additional 30 games either in league or tournament, or a combination of both. At least seventy of the total league games must be bowled in a house other than the bowler's "home" lanes; and all leagues and tournaments must be sanctioned through the local association.

Among the prestige tournaments that figure in the ranking system for local bowlers are: the Southern Printers Tournament, Fair Lanes Summer Tour, Bowl America's Topper Classic, Nation's Capital Singles Classic, the Bowl Magazine Tournament, the MWBPA Invitational, and the City Championships tournament.
