The Virginia Queens was organized in an effort to "promote bowling as a major sport in the State of Virginia." Membership is open to all WIBC members who have an average of 165 or more for at least 36 games. Members of the WPBA are ineligible for membership in the VBQ.

The tournament format includes two four game blocks on Saturday and then again two more blocks of four on Sunday. The winner is determined by total scratch pinfall for the entire 16 games. There are also special "out of the money" awards for the high 4 game block, high 8 game block (same day) and high game.
