

Blair and Riley Win MWBPA Holiday Doubles

Donna Blair and Robert Riley, bowling out of Bowl America Silver Spring, won the abbreviated 1986 MWBPA Holiday Doubles.

The Blair-Riley duo led the three-game qualifying to reach the six-team finals at Annandale Bowling Center. Their handicapped three-game total was 1,301 (1,178 plus 123) and it topped the field of nineteen teams that had won their eligibility to bowl in the finals by winning the MWBPA center levels.

In all, 126 couples attempted to reach the finals at the center level of qualifying, a change from recent formats.

In the head-to-head match play finals, Blair-Riley had a scratch total of 2,169, won all six games (receiving 300 bonus pins), and received 246 pins handicap for their winning total of 2,715, a 112-pin victory. The duo won \$600.

Finishing second was the team of Charlene Cooper and Phil Langhorn from Parkland with a 2,603 total worth \$300. To round out the top three, Linda Puckett and Gary Neuman, Annandale Bowling Center, had a 2,600 total and won \$150.
