

Three Area Youths Win MTBC Scholarships

Three local youths were among eight high school seniors who won \$7,000 in scholarships in the 8th annual Maryland Tenpin Bowling Council Scholarship Tournament, which took place last month at Terrace Lanes in Frederick. A total of 56 seniors competed.

Local winners included:

- Anthony Chapman of Landover, who won a \$1,000 scholarship for his first place finish in the boys' scratch category. Chapman, who rolls at Parkland, attends DeMatha High, and has applied to Temple University, scored 176-175-232-257-195-186 / 1,221.
- Bill Anhalt of Crofton, who won a \$750 scholarship for finishing second to Chapman. Anhalt bowls at Crofton and attends Arundel High. He shot 1,143 on games of 188-213-203-172-178-189.
- Kevin Cunningham of Rockville, who won a \$750 scholarship for his second place finish in the boy's handicap division. Cunningham rolls at Shady Grove and shot 1,300 on games of 176-189-142-199-169-173 (plus 252 handicap).

The MTBC has awarded \$43,000 in scholarships in eight years.
