Jason Lewis of Mitchellville and Chad McKinney of Landover finished second with 1,046. Third-place honors went to Danny Polley of Springfield and David Cole of Kingstown, Va., with 1,035.

The high doubles game awards went to Lewis and McKinney with 423 and Jeff Bridgman of Herndon and Chauvon Md-Fadden of Herndon with 403.

Additional honors were earned by Chris Logan of Dale City with the high series of 584 and game of 241. Steve Dorman of Woodbridge had the second high series with 580.

Those who scored the top 10 series qualified for May's Tournament of Champions, which consists of a three-game qualifying block, match play, and a stepladder finals. There will be one more qualifying tournament-a singles event this spring.
