Ewald Earns \$5000 For Awesome Dynoroos Mini Sweeper Victory

2002 Mini Eliminator Champion David Ewald, Warren, Michigan averaged 250.37 for eight matches to claim the \$5000 Super Mini Eliminator Dynoroos Matchplay Sweeper Wednesday evening. Ewald rolled games of 247, 225, 258, 296, 242, 232, and 278 to make it to the final match against Mark Siders, Columbus, Ohio.

In the championship game, the two undefeated players traded strikes until Ewald put the match

away in the final frames. Ewald defeated Siders 225-206 in the title match. Ewald rolled Brunswick balls to win the event.
