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### NCAUSBCA BOWLERS SUPPORT BOWL FOR THE CURE® Local bowlers help strike back at breast cancer

**Nation's Capital Area** -- More than 2,000 local bowlers are expected to knock down pins to knock out breast cancer with the Nation's Capital Area USBC Association (NCAUSBCA) at the Bowl for the Cure® Day event being held at Bowl America Shirley on February 18, 2012 from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM.

This year, local bowlers hope to raise more than \$50,000 to contribute to Bowl for the Cure, a year-round fund-raising and awareness initiative organized by the United States Bowling Congress in support of the Susan G. Komen for the Cure®. Bowlers around the United States organize tournaments, bowl-a-thons, raffles, auctions, and more each year to support Bowl for the Cure.
