FOR THE RECORD

Following its Youth Committee Planning Meeting on June 4, there were several changes announced regarding youth events for the 2017-2018 season. Perhaps the biggest was the addition of a fourth division for the Invitational Scratch Singles Tournament, which will take place January 20-21, 27-28, and February 4 at centers to be determined. The new division breakdown: A (195 and Up), B (180-194), C (165-179), and D (150-164). The first two rounds will have two shifts to permit staff more flexibility in choosing centers, and scholarship brackets again will run within each division during both rounds. A Sport shot again will be used, and averages from leagues using either a Sport or Challenge pattern will be adjusted per the published USBC average adjustment charts. A fundraiser for the event for adult bowlers will take place on February 3 and 4. ... For the Vern Burke Scholarship Tournament (November 12 and March 25 at Bowl America Manassas), the former Division 1 (Scratch) will change to Handicap for averages of 185 and above, while Division 2 now will be for averages of 165-184. The scratch division is changing to an optional added division for a reduced fee (\$10) using the handicap division scores and adding a new Sport shot scratch division for both events.

NCAUSBCA Hall of Famer Mary Kearns-Miller of Edinburg, Va., died June 25 after a lengthy battle with kidney disease. She was 83. Kearns-Miller became a director on the WDCAWBA board in 1967 and later served as assistant sergeant-at-arms and fifth and second vice president. In 1988, she won the President's Award for outstanding service. On the lanes, her achievements include a 269 game, 688 series, and she twice apppeared in the "Top 10" rankings. She earned a WDCAWBA City Tournament Doubles title and had a second-place finish in the MWBPA Invitational Tournament. She was inducted into the Hall of Fame in 1995.

Sean P. Sanborn of Chantilly, Va., recently was indefinitely suspended from membership in USBC and must not bowl in any USBC leagues and tournaments or hold office in any USBC league, tournament, or state or local association. ... Meanwhile, Stefin J. Nelson of Fort Myer, Va., has been reinstated to membership.

Two 2015-2016 average updates: (1) Bryan E. Miller, 221 for 20 games in the Tuesday Night Strikers at Bowl America Bull Run; (2) Sarah Marbach, 117 for 48 games in the Linda Bowen Memorial at Bowl America Gaithersburg.

Enjoy your summer months

Summertime for me always means a time to enjoy outdoor activities. However, since I love the game of bowling, I have come to realize that I will need to spend some time indoors, hopefully in a bowling center keeping my game sharp and bowling in tournaments. For some of you, this may also mean joining a summer league and/or practicing while staying cool. No matter how you approach the summer months, please continue to improve your game.

This past April, I had an opportunity to attend my first USBC Convention and represent our association. I was amazed to see so many individuals from across the U.S. representing their local associations. It also allowed me to meet other individuals who shared ideas for fund-raising for BVL and local supporting programs. There were over 800 voting delegates in attendance to gain insight on the processes USBC plans to enhance the bowling experience and to vote on rule and amendment changes that will affect each of you during the upcoming league and tournament competitions.

Each year during our Annual Meeting, delegates are elected to represent your local association at the USBC Convention. I strongly recommend that you get more involved and place your name on the ballot to become a delegate for next year's convention in Reno, Nev. I feel certain that you, too, will enjoy the experience and opportunity to get first-hand information on what USBC is planning for all of its members.

Did you know the USBC mem-

bership carries responsibilities? A new rule was adopted by the USBC board of directors to let its members know their responsibilities:

Rule 16a. - **Responsibilities.** An individual bowling in USBC leagues and tournaments is responsible for but not limited to:

- 1. Ensuring they have the correct membership to participate.
- 2. Abiding by USBC rules.
- 3. Abiding by league or tournament rules.
- 4. Ensuring their average is correct, prior to participation.
- 5. Reporting prize winnings as stated in the tournament rules and/or Rule 319d.
- 6. Reporting any tournament average adjustment/rerate in accordance with Rule 319c.
- 7. Using a national average rerate.

You should remember that average adjustment/rerate is the average a tournament manager may give a bowler to use in his/her tournament. This average must be reported to any future tournaments, for all handicapped or classified competition, unless the tournament rules state otherwise. If a national average rerate is issued, the bowler must report and use the rerated average or established higher average for all handicapped or classified competition.

Have a wonder summer, and be on the lookout for the league jamboree coming to your bowling center prior to the 2017-2018 season. If you should have any questions, please contact the association office or myself at president@ ncausbca.org.

Standard vs. Basic membership know the difference!

The 2017 summer season is in full swing, and it's still the same old thing as far as a Basic versus a Standard USBC membership know the difference and what benefits you get based on your choice of membership.

The 2017-2018 tournament season is almost upon us, beginning with the NCAUSBCA 36th Annual Senior Tournament at Bowl America Gaithersburg on October 14-15, 21-22, and 28-29, followed by the Mixed Tournament in Support of BVL on December 9-10 at Bowl America Shirley. The current plan is to replace the Mixed Scratch Doubles Tournament with a mixed doubles event in the February time slot. The Youth Championship Tournament is set for March 3-4 and 10-11 at Bowl America Fairfax. The Open Championship Tournament will take place April 7-8, 14-15, and 21-22 at Rinaldi's Riverdale Bowl (team) and AMF Capital Plaza (singles & doubles). The Women's Championship Tournament will occur on March 10-11 and 17-18 at Bowl America Burke. Come out and join in the fun, and let's make the 2017-2018 tournament season a great one.

Some of the changes for the upcoming season:

> USBC's portion of the membership will be \$13.00, while the local association membership remains at \$10.00, and state membership remains at \$1.00, thus bringing the standard membership total to \$24.00.

> There is now a Challenge Conversion Chart. Starting with the 2017-2018 season, when a league submits its certification, the league secretary must choose one, and only one, of three lane condition options on the application—*Standard, Challenge,* or *Sport.*

> USBC has modified the reporting requirement for tournament winnings in Rule 319d—the level has been lowered to \$300 instead of \$600.

We urge you to attend the fall jamboree held in your center so that you can meet you lane representative(s). We will begin preparing winter league kits for distribution to the centers shortly, as a few centers will have its meeting in July.

We still have several leagues that have not submitted final averages from the 2016-2017 winter season, so bowlers in those leagues may not be included in this year's *Annual Averages* book. We will maintain an updated version on our Web site.

Senior assistance; ball weight; targeting down the lane

Q. I have been asked to help with a senior bowling class. Do you have any hints on helping seniors?

A. Being a senior myself, I think I have some ideas on the subject since I have instructed seniors from time to time. First, you have to remember with seniors that you must first ask them about any physical conditions that really can affect the things they might be able to do, such as arthritis or joint replacement, knees, or hips. You have to work with what they have physically.

I just coached a group of six ladies ages 77 to 83 who had slow speed and not much fluidity. Mostly I had them work on keeping their eyes on the target till the ball rolls through it to help with accuracy, then on the proper place to line up for spares. With most seniors to get the best out of their game, helping with the alignment for spares will get them the most improvement. Then checking the ball for weight and drilling will be the next thing to look at. Many are using the wrong weight ball, and spans and pitches need correction.

For you seniors out there that may be having problems with sore fingers and wrists and hands, go to your local pro shop and get your ball checked both for weight and for drilling. Bowling is supposed to be fun, not torture. Lessons are also good for you to be able to get the most out of your physical game no matter what problems you may have. When there's a will, there's a way.

I have always used a 15-pound ball and quit because of a sore wrist, so I am thinking about going down to a 14-pound ball. Do you think the lower weight will hurt my scoring?

A. I doubt that your scores will go down much. The bowling balls today are very powerful. You might notice a few weight-related 10pins, but the lower weight should take some pressure off the wrist. So bowling pain-free and with more control, plus some added speed, should make up any difference the occasional extra 10 you might leave.

Q. When I bowl, I target at the second arrow or close to that. I have heard that looking down the lane will keep the ball from hooking early. Is this true?

A. Targeting down the lane can help early hook. Sometimes, though, you might want the ball to hook a little earlier.

What I do when warming up for league or tournament is start by targeting about 10 feet past the arrows. Pick a dark or light board on the lane; you want to use, say, the 10-board or second arrow. If the ball goes high, look further down toward the pins—say, 40 to 45 feet. Some lanes have tracer marks down there if they do target there.

If the ball goes light and you think you need earlier roll, target at the arrows. My name for this is the "three-spot system"—arrows, midlane area, or the 40-to-45 foot or tracer board area. This works great for small lane adjustments when a larger move is not called for.
