Scholarships do not render void accumulated SMART funds

An area youth bowler with several years of eligibility remaining recently considered joining an adult league because he had heard that his accumulated SMART (Scholarship Management and Account Reporting for Tenpins) funds would be unusable were he to accept a college scholarship. As a top student, he believes such an offer likely would happen.

In an attempt to obtain some facts, *BOWL Magazine* contacted and received a response from SMART Brand Manager Laurie Smetek, who wrote the following:

I am not personally aware of an example where SMART funds could not be used due to accepting an academic scholarship. The SMART program allows for youth to use their scholarship funds at almost every vocational school or college throughout the country. SMART funds can be used in conjunction with academic scholarships. SMART funds may be applied to the following:

- Tuition fees
- On-campus meal plans
- On-campus housing plans
- Textbooks
- Required class supplies

It is rare for academic scholarships to cover every dol-

lar of the expenses above for all of college. SMART funds can be used to cover any expenses above that are not covered by academic scholarship. In the extraordinary situation that a student receives academic scholarships to cover every dollar of costs associated with an undergraduate degree, SMART funds can be used for graduate school.

We urge parents not to move youth bowlers into adult competition and earn cash prizes unless they are fully informed of the tradeoffs. Earning cash prizes jeopardizes amateur status for not only USBC youth events, but potentially with high school and college athletics as well.

Earlier this year, SMART announced an income earnings distribution of \$1.75 million to providers' funds for 2018. The SMART board makes income earnings distributions each May based on earnings from the previous year. In addition, during the last year, nearly 6,000 recipients successfully used funds from SMART accounts.

No change in adult dues; youth dues reduced

Another season has for most already begun, so hopefully your summer was enjoyable. Adult certification fees are unchanged from last season:

➤ **Standard:** \$24.00.

➤ **Basic:** \$11.00 (for “short-season” leagues only, no awards offered).

➤ **Local & (Va.) State:** \$11.00 (for example, a bowler who paid 2018-2019 dues in a league in Baltimore).

➤ **Local Only:** \$10.00 (a bowler who paid dues in a Virginia league through *another* Virginia association, such as Richmond).

Meanwhile, the association board has approved a reduction of youth certification fees from \$12 to \$10 (including local awards), a pretty good deal.

There no doubt has been a lot of buzz about the elimination of

the bowling ball balance hole, which currently begins in 2020, and the use only of a dry towel to wipe your ball, which begins August 2019. By all means, keep checking our Web site at ncausbca.org for updates on these and other items, i.e., tournaments, Hall of Fame, Annual Membership Meeting, etc. If you are a league secretary, officer, or bowler, the site is a treasure trove of information, especially the items found in the “Secretary’s Corner.”

I hope your league organization meeting went well. It’s most important to keep to the standard for getting the prize fund together by Week 5 as well as performing at least *one* audit midway through the season—better safe than sorry!

Hall of Famer Joe Clark dies

NCAUSBCA Hall of Fame member Joseph Clark Jr. died September 7, 2018. He was 99.



After moving to Virginia in 1956, Joe bowled on three state championship teams. His high average was 201 in 1961. He had a 300 game and three 299s to his credit.

Off the lanes, he was a manager or general manager at Pentagon City Bowling Center, Ten Pin Coliseum, Bowl America Shirley, and Colony Lanes, which became the original Bowl America Woodbridge in 1970.

Although Joe excelled as a bowler and administrator, his forte was as an instructor. He taught bowling for over 60 years and believed that bowling, like any other sport, has certain basic fundamentals that need to be learned. Once people understand these fundamentals, their skill level improves and bowling becomes more enjoyable. Joe was always willing to give assistance to bowlers of any average, and he was directly responsible for introducing thousands of people to bowling, and his influence touched thousands more.

He was a Hall of Fame member of the “Class of 1993.”

NCAUSBCA Hall of Fame to welcome Tony Walton

54th Annual Induction & Dinner Celebration set for November 3

Tony Walton has a lengthy record of achievement across several decades in scratch bowling. He was one of the top youth bowlers to emerge from the Washington, D.C. area in the 1980s. Tony represented the District in the United States Youth Games from 1979 to 1984, winning five team gold medals along with four gold medals and a silver medal in individual events. In his final season as a youth in 1985, he averaged 202.



Tony has won 32 adult scratch tournaments and three PBA regional titles (two Eastern and one Southern) since 1985. Our local and mid-Atlantic region saw a number of scratch tournament clubs form in the 1990s, such as Tournament Concepts, Capital Area Masters, Virginia Lottery Tour,

and others. These tournament clubs usually conducted monthly tournaments and featured many of the best bowlers from the region. Tony was 1995 Tournament Concepts Player of the Year, a year after being runner-up for the award.

Tony has rolled 32 perfect games, including two in PBA competition, and five 800 series. He has been a staff member of several bowling manufacturers, including Ebonite (1997-1998), Roto Grip (2003-2005), Columbia 300 (2007-2009), Brunswick / DV8 / Radical (2011-2014), and Vise Grip Inserts (since 1994). He was the 2006 Hammer Challenge champion in York, Pa., winning \$3,000, and was the 2011 Jerry Dawson Classic champion.

Tony is a former proprietor of the Twelve In A Row Pro Shop. In 2002, he established the Vir-Mar Scratch Bowlers Tour (VMS-BT) tournament club. This club continued the culture of competitive scratch bowling for the D.C. / Baltimore / Virginia region outside of the PBA regional circuit, which usually requires many hours of travel to reach the tournament site and often precludes many top bowlers with good career jobs from participating in high-level competitions.

Given his record of winning scratch tournaments across four decades against local and PBA competitors, and for providing a service of running scratch tournaments, Tony Walton is a welcome addition to the NCAUSBCA Hall of Fame.

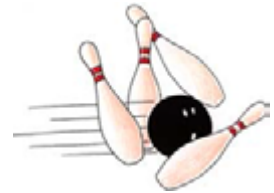

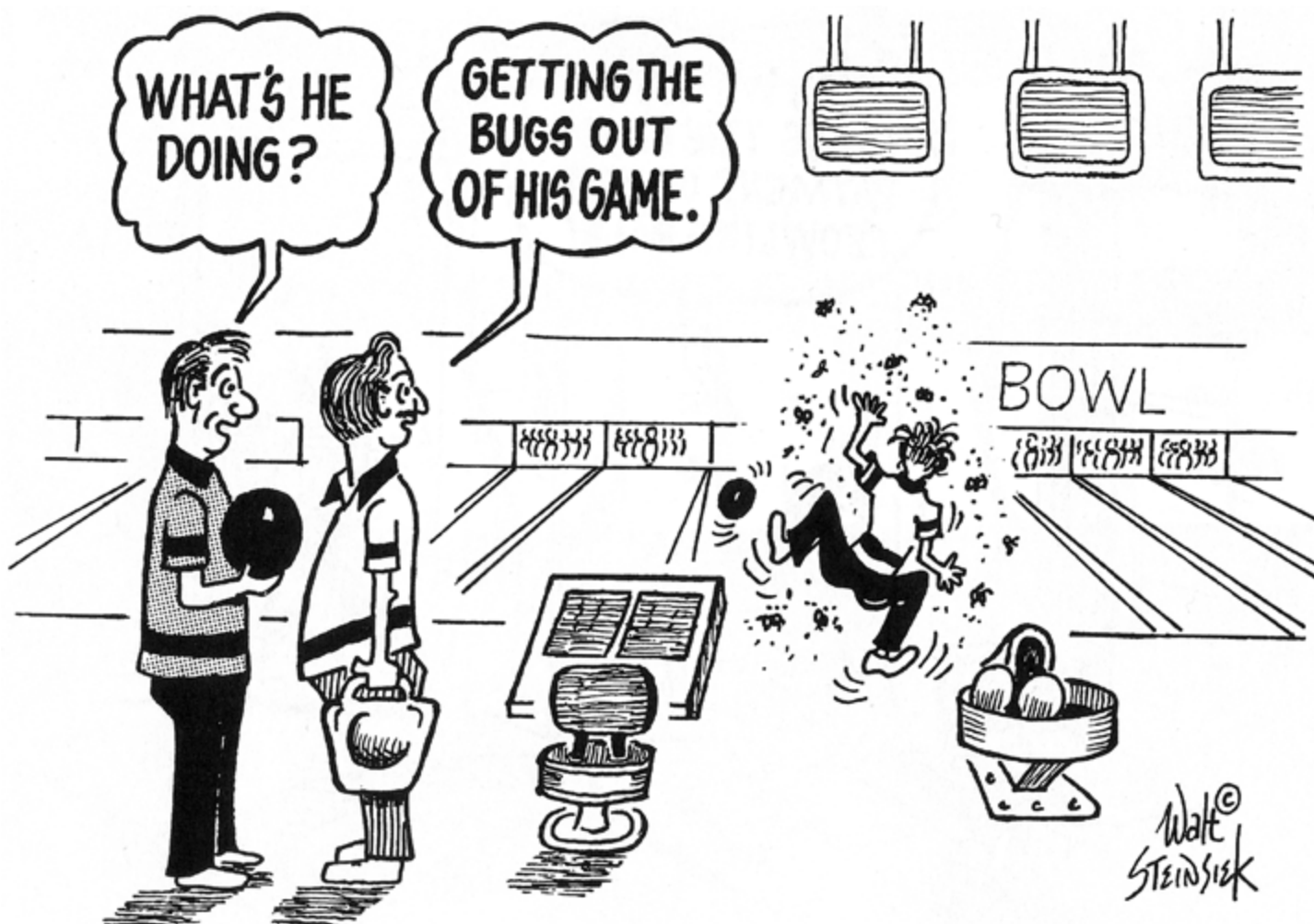
