Three-unit lane dressing rule suspended indefinitely by USBC Equipment Specifications Committee

ARLINGTON, Texas — After reviewing recent research on lane dressing and examining the current rules about how lane oil is applied, the United States Bowling Congress Equipment Specifications Committee determined the three-unit rule, required at the time oil is applied to a lane, no longer is applicable and will be suspended.

The USBC Equipment Specifications and Certifications team's research has shown advancements in technology, including how today's bowling balls drastically alter any oil pattern applied to a lane surface, have made the rule obsolete.

Instituted by the American Bowling Congress in 1992, the three-unit rule states lane dressing could be applied in any amount and any distance, as long as there was a minimum of three units, and it became the only standard oil pattern regulation.

The review of the three-unit rule is a continuation of the USBC's commitment to continually explore all facets in bowling while thinking about the future of the sport.

"At this time, it makes sense to suspend the rule but

USBC MEMBERS HAVE BOWL.COM SINGLE SIGN-ON

The United States Bowling Congress has launched the USBC Community Login for BOWL.com, providing USBC members with a single sign-on for many of USBC's online platforms. The USBC Community Login already is used by USBC members to register for the USBC Open and Women's Championships, the Youth Open Championships, and for BowlTV.com, USBC's livestream platform. By incorporating user logins for BOWL.com, which allows members to use popular applications such as Find a Member, along with the mobile app and SMART accounts, USBC members now have one login for many of the BOWL.com programs and for tournament registration. "Connecting USBC platforms with a single sign-on has been an important long-term goal and major technology priority for USBC," USBC Deputy Executive Director Jason Overstreet said. "We know our members want the convenience of one login to access popular platforms such as Find A Member, tournament registration, and BowlTV." For those who already have an account on BOWL.com, they will notice a new look during the sign-in process through the USBC Community Login, though they will be able to use their current username and password. For those who already have a password for USBC's Event Registration platform - used for the USBC Open Championships and USBC Women's Championships, for example, or for BowlTV.com - users will use that username and password for the USBC Community Login.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE • MICHAEL TINSLEY

Let's keep our cool on the lanes

At long last, summer has arrived and another long winter bowling season has been completed. Now is the time to reflect on the past season—what we did right, what we did wrong, and how to improve on what we did well and start working to correct what we didn't do so well.

One of the things some of us need to work on is our temperament/reaction to unfavorable results from a poorly executed shot or the results a bad break, i.e., the 7–10 split on a pocket hit. What we have to realize is

Now to discuss a rule change for the coming season that involves a dry towel. Once practice begins, you can only use a dry towel to clean your bowling ball. If for some reason you are unable to clean the belt residue from your ball, you are to consult a league/tournament official for permission to use something other than a dry towel.

This permission is not open-ended. Each time you are unable to clear your ball of residue, you must contact a league/tournament official for guidance.

What we have to realize is people are watching, whether you are the association president or the average bowler.

people are watching, whether you are the association president or the average bowler. Your demeanor can reflect poorly on you and your team. You can't do anything about the last shot, so put it behind you and compose yourself and prepare to pick up as many pins on your spare as you can.

So while you practice this summer, remember to work on being a better person on the lanes. Your teammates as well other members of your league will appreciate it. You'll be surprised by the results.

All league presidents and secretaries should check with their bowling center to verify that the contract you signed is what you agreed to as well as to have the center verify that the league bowling on the same night as you doesn't have more lanes assigned than the center can accommodate on that given night.

With all that said, enjoy your summer, and I'll look forward to seeing you in the upcoming season.

Summer league final averages must be submitted

If you bowl in a summer league, you have completed much of your schedule, so hopefully the prize list has been distributed and, above all, you are having fun. For some, teachers, etc., summer is the only time that you can bowl, or maybe you are just bowling with your children in one of the youth/adult leagues. In any event, secretaries must submit those final averages so that we can post them online.

Also, please note that memberships purchased during the summer are only good for the summer. If you are in a Basic league, the membership is *only* good for that league.

We are in the process of inspecting lanes for the 2019-2020 bowling season. We have enlisted the help of bowlers from several youth leagues.

Every center in the area has to be inspected annually so that all award scores bowled can be approved. Everything is inspected from the foul line to the pin decks, the gutters, and even the pinspotter is checked to see if the tolerances are in line with USBC specifications. If you would like to help out, just give the office a call at 301/499-1693.

Our Women's and Open Championships have been completed, and most seemed to enjoy the bowling this year. Both tournaments featured for the first time a Crossover Doubles event that generated several positive comments. Bowlers had an opportunity to bowl with multiple part-

ners from the same squad. From the reviews we received, this event will be offered in our 2019 Senior Tournament held at Bowl America Falls Church October 12-13, 19-20, and 26-27. Information about this and other association events can be found on this site.

The May 2019 Virginia Lottery "Pick 3" fund-raiser checks were distributed, and we wish to thank all those who participated. This was the highest participation we have had since we started two years ago, due in large part to league secretaries Carolyn Ivory, Brenda "Tweeti" Barnett-Johnson, and Ronald Folks, plus our Board of Directors and office staff that spread the word and squeezed money out of everyone they met. This time, we paid out \$2,035, with several \$150 and \$100 winners. As a reminder, all funds raised are used to pay for local association awards.

As a result of legislation passed at this year's USBC Annual Meeting, final averages now will need to be submitted to the association office no later than 15 days after the final league session. Failure to do so could result in charges being brought against secretaries.

Last but not least: Thanks to all those who contributed to the BVL this season, we were able to send a check for **\$16,000** to BVL headquarters. This amount is our highest in several years, so once again, thanks for your generosity on behalf of the veterans and active service personnel everywhere.

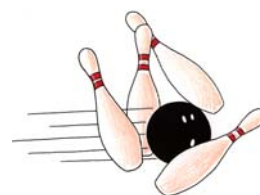

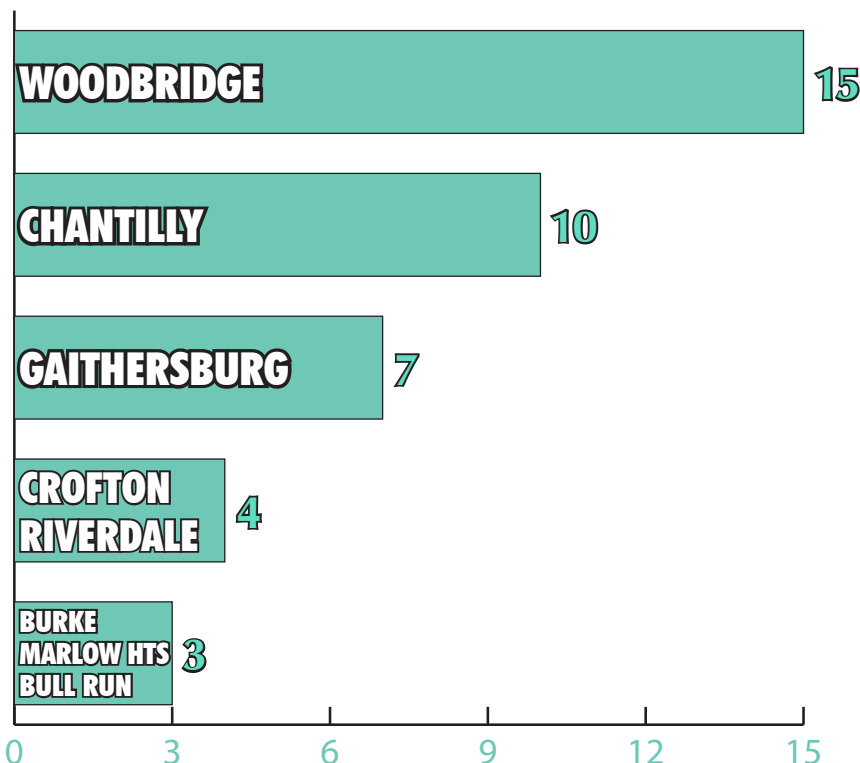

continue to monitor leagues and competitions as the equipment we use, and the lanes on which we compete, continue to evolve,” USBC Equipment Specifications chair Andrew Cain said. “A review of the current lane-dressing regulation was simply the next logical phase of research and one within which the applicability of the three-unit rule itself was called into question. This process of constant inquiry and ensuing research is central to maintaining the integrity of our sport.”

With the suspension of the three-unit rule, local associations no longer will be required to submit an annual Lane Dressing Inspection Report (LDIR) for its centers.

The research performed at the International Training and Research Center in Arlington showed lane patterns are drastically altered by the use of today’s bowling balls, and most patterns likely do not comply with the three-unit rule by the end of a league session.

USBC will continue to run Sport-compliant patterns for its national events, such as the USBC Open and Women’s Championships, the Junior

Gold Championships and its major short-duration events. USBC also will maintain the Standard, Challenge, and Sport lane conditions average conversion charts, for those who wish to compete in leagues and tournaments on challenging lane conditions.

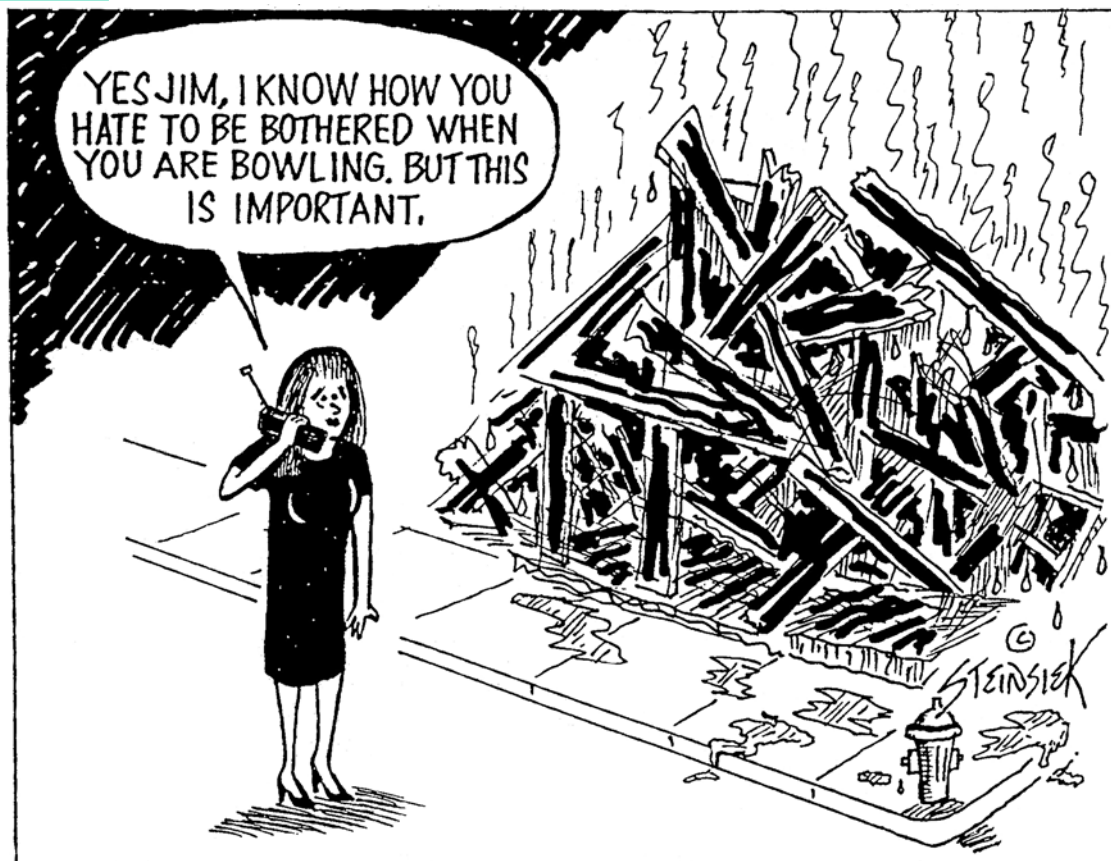
The Equipment Specifications Committee also set the specs for any hole drilled in a bowling ball.

Effective Aug. 1, 2020, drilled holes cannot exceed a diameter of 1-9/16 inches and a hole cannot have a depth of more than 4-1/2 inches. The specification includes holes in which removable devices are used, though the holes size specifically was set to allow all existing removeable devises to remain.

Also, because any gripping hole that does not have the thumb or fingers inserted into it throughout the approach would be classified as a balance hole, which is not allowed as of Aug. 1, 2020, any secondary hole drilled inside of a gripping hole that is not intended for gripping purpose is considered a void and not allowed, except for vent holes.
