



Team USA accepting resumes for 2023 IBF World Senior Championships

ARLINGTON, Texas – The Team USA program has opened the application portal for competitors to submit resumes to represent the United States at the 2023 International Bowling Federation World Senior Championships in Cali, Colombia.

The 2023 event will be taking place Dec. 5-15 at Bolera Departamental, and Team USA's squad will feature four men and four women looking to claim gold

Those selected will receive a paid entry into the events, airfare, lodging and official uniforms.

in team, doubles and singles competition, along with all-events for an athlete's overall performance at the tournament.

In order to be eligible to submit a resume, athletes must be born in or before 1973. Team members will be selected by the National Selection Committee from the submitted applications, which will be accepted through Sept. 17.

MULTI-NATION WORKING GROUP SUBMITS PROPOSED CHANGES TO INTERNATIONAL **BOWLING** FEDERATION ARTICLES

An international working group representing seven countries is proposing a package of amendments to the International Bowling Federation's Articles of Association. A vote on the amendments is expected to occur at the IBF General Meeting on Oct. 6, 2023 in Kuwait. The working group proposals are supported by several countries, including the U.S. The working group encourages federations to support these proposals to bring change to IBF. The nations of the working group issued a joint statement that includes: "Bowling needs a fundamental change at IBF. These proposals will bring change. Bowling needs change at IBF so our World Championships will have a true competition committee focused on creating a schedule and format allowing more federations to compete. Bowling needs change at IBF to compel the organization to share financial reports. Federations have not seen financial reports since 2019."

Know your league rules!

Welcome, bowlers to the 2023-2024 season. It is nice to be back on the lanes. Hopefully, your leagues are growing, your game is improving, and you brought a friend to join the fun of league bowling.

Bowlers are key! An essential part of playing a sport is knowing the rules. Start the season by reading the USBC Playing Rules 2023-2024 book. Attend your league organization meeting to receive important information regarding the league and bowling center. The league will vote to approve the league rules and a prize list. Team Captain (104h), you are responsible for your team by collecting dues, determining the roster, entering the lineup on the recap sheet, and paying each team member within 15 days after

receiving prize money.

League Officers on Duty. League officers know the league rules. Key duties officers are required to perform are listed below. Go to Rule 104 in the Playing Rules for a complete list of duties.

- > Presidents (104b), set up your bank account with your treasurer, appoint the prize and audit committees and enforce the rules.
- > Vice President (104c), in the president's absence, be prepared to perform the president's duties.
- > Secretary (104d), have each participant complete a mem-

bership card application (including those who paid online). Deliver the completed league application form along with the membership application cards with appropriate dues to the local association manager within 30 days of re*ceipt*—and continue this with additional membership applications throughout the season. Record the minutes of all league meetings and notify the team captains of league meetings. Provide a current standing sheet. Report scores meetings and, state, and local association awards. Submit a completed award application within 20 days. Notify the local association manager within 48 hours of scores eligible for USBC honor score recognition. > Treasurer (104e) Establish a bank account in the league's name with the signatures of at least two officers needed for withdrawals. Ensure the statement is sent to the league president. Deposit all league funds within one week of receipt. Provide a complete account of all receipts and disbursements. Provide a current financial statement to each team captain and officer as requested. Distribute all prizes. > Sergeant-at-Arms (104f). Perform duties as may be re-

quired by the president or the board of directors.

MANAGER'S MEMO • RONALD McGREGOR

Preseason questions and situations

It's almost September and some leagues are already a few sessions into the season. The lane reps program is back, and if you aren't sure who your rep is, click here.

A few recurring questions and situations from the league meetings that the reps attended are addressed:

1. Can we break ties using total pins for positions at the end of the season?

No, it's against USBC rules, and Rule 118 covers this topic. This is not a rule a league can modify.

2. Do we have to have a prize list by the fifth week?

a. Yes, see Rule 106. It is the President's duty to appoint the prize committee by week five.

b. If this is not done, you risk violating the bonding agreement with USBC.

3. Many bowlers have opted to pay for or renew their member-ship online.

Great if you do, but please check to make sure the trans-

action (usually posted within 48 hours) went through. Also, bowlers are still required to fill out a membership card for *each* league in which they bowl.

4. No substances allowed on the soles of bowling shoes:

Rule 12: Detracting from the possibility of other players having normal conditions is prohibited. This includes:

a. The application of any foreign substance on any part of the approach.

b. Improperly applying talcum powder, pumice, soap stone, rosin, or any other foreign substance on the shoes causing the substance to be transferred to the approach.

c. Soft rubber soles or heels that rub off on the approach.

5. At least one audit should be conducted during the season to avoid any nasty surprises at payoff night; it is also a President's duty.

Every season, some league gets into trouble over this one.

6. A reminder for the secretary to send the league application form along with the membership cards to the local association office within 30 days of receipt so that the office staff can process the league.

7. Can a substitute be used on the first night of bowling?

Rule 112 covers this situation as follows:

If a rostered bowler is absent the first night of bowling, is an absentee or vacancy score used?

a. An absentee score is used unless otherwise provided by league rules or past precedent established in the league.

b. If there is a question as to whether the absent individual is a member of the team's roster, the league's board of directors decides the matter.

8. Is the local association giving awards this season?

Yes. Please visit "Secretary's Corner" on our site for forms and other information.

Enjoy the season, have fun, and by all means give the office a call or speak with your lane representative if you need help with anything to ensure the smooth running of your league.

"Class of 2023" to be inducted September 23 at Bolling Air Force Base Officers' Club

Though he makes it look effortless, Bobby Hall II has spent countless hours honing in on the skills



required for him to compete at the highest level of the game, both within the NCAUSBCA and on the Professional Bowlers Association (PBA) Tour. He began bowling at age 6 at Riggs Plaza Bowl in Chillum. Marvland. He started out bowling in youth leagues, made the Invita-

tional finals in 1988, and after becoming an adult league bowler, joined the PBA in 1994 at age 24.

Bobby has over 90 perfect games, countless 299s, and over 50 800 series. His achievements go back over 40 years and continue to this day.

On March 3, 1994, he bowled his first 800 series, an 801 (267-258-276) in league play at Fair Lanes University. The following night, he returned and rolled an 863 (298-285-280). At this time, 800s were not common, and this was believed to be the first time an area bowler scored consecutive 800s.

His current high series is 879 (300-300-279) at AMF Marlow Heights, and with a current average of 241, it is safe to say his achievements

Bobby has won numerous titles locally and regionally. He is a two-time holder of the NCAUS-BCA Championship Tournament All-Events title, and he has won numerous local tournaments, including Money Bags Scratch events and the Virginia-Maryland Scratch Bowlers

After qualifying second in the Regional Players Invitational Pro Champions Tournament, Bobby fulfilled a lifelong dream by earning and exemption on the 2010-2011 PBA Tour, making him the

Chhoeun To was 29-years-old the year he bowled in his first league, setting a 187 average



for 87 games in the 1997-98 Odds and Ends League at Bowl America Falls Church. Although having a 187 league average the first season would have thrilled most bowlers, for Chhoeun it only fueled an intense desire to become an elite player. From that point on, and after

hundreds of hours of dedicated practice, Chhoeun has become a top flight scratch bowler, compiling an impressive list of bowling achievements within and beyond the Nation's Capital Area.

A summary of Chhoeun's bowling accomplishments substantiate that fact:

➤ He was ranked in the "Top 10" of the association's official men's rankings for the 2004-05 (9th, 217.188), 2005-06 (3rd, 227.048), and 2006-07 (5th, 221.444) seasons.

> He won the 2008 Virginia State Scratch All-Events title.

> He won the 2010 NCAUSBCA Open Tournament Scratch Singles title.

> In 2012, he and Mike Manolis won the Virginia State Tournament Scratch Doubles event.

> Chhoeun won the Scratch All-Events title in the 2016 Mixed Tournament in Support of BVL and twice (2018 and 2021) was a member of the team winning the Scratch Doubles event.

> Chhoeun was a back-to-back winner of TNBA's Eastern Division Senior Men's event of the Bill Rhodman Classic (2019 and 2021).

> Among his many other recent tournament wins were the 2019 Motiv Scratch Challenge, the 2021 Box of Chocolates tournament, and wins in the Virginia-Maryland Scratch Bowlers Tour.
