TOURNAMENT RULES

- Eligibility: Only current members of the Nation's Capital Area Bowling Association and/or the Washington D.C. Area Women's Bowling Association are eligible to bowl in this tournament. Nonmembers living within the jurisdiction of these associations who are not members of another association may enter by paying affiliate membership fee of \$16.00 ABC or \$20.00 WIBC. Payment of coassociation fees for membership will not be accepted at the tournament site.
- 2) Tournament will be a Scratch Doubles event consisting of three (3) games. A person may re-enter but only cash once with the same partner.
- 3) Each team must consist of one (1) member who has bowled an ABC-sanctioned 700 series and one (1) member who has bowled a WIBC-sanctioned 600 series at time of check-in.
- 4) Check-in time is not later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the squad. Any player arriving after the game has started will be allowed to bowl, and score(s) will count beginning in the frame being bowled. Zeroes will be given for frames missed.
- 5) Entry fee will be \$62 per team for "Early Bird" entry, which must be submitted with the entry form. The fee covers \$43.00 prize fund, \$15.00 lineage, and \$4.00 expense fee. Walk-in fee will be \$72.00 per team. Re-entry into another squad will be \$62.00 per team. You may only cash once with the same partner. A \$20.00 administrative fee, plus bank charges, will be added to all returned checks
- 6) Prize money will be returned at least 1 in 10 to the highest scratch scores. Prize money will be returned 100%.
- 7) Walk-ins will be accepted no later than 30 minutes before the scheduled squad time of bowling, if lanes are available.
- 8) Automatic scorers will be official during the progress of the game, and scores will be entered on the official score sheets by the bowler. Scores lost due to malfunction of automatic scorers shall be rebowled.
- 9) ABC Rule 330 will apply. (A bowler must use the same hand to deliver the bowling ball throughout the tournament.)
- **10)** A \$500.00 bond will be awarded to the first completed 300 game bowled in tournament play. Only one bond will be issued. Tournament director decision is final.
- 11) An optional singles event will be done using the scores bowled in the doubles to determine the winner. There will be a male division and a female division. Entry fee is \$5.00—all going to the prize fund. Prize money will be paid out at least 1 in 10. Prize fund will be returned 100%.
