
Holmes finishes third, collects \$9,000 in Ebonite PBA Senior Championship

Third-seeded Bobby Holmes of Adelphi defeated Dan Roche of Downey, Calif., 279-162 before falling to eventual champion Gene Stus of Allen Park, Mich., 237-211 during last month's nationally-televised ESPN finals of the Ebonite PBA Senior Championship at Galaxy Lanes in Venice, Fla. Holmes, who averaged 218.7 for his 56 qualifying games and had a 14-8-2 match-play record, took home \$9,000.
