


Bob Michaelson Hits Second 700 Set



700 SET. Bob Michaelson, 17, bowling in the Monday Night Mixed Five at Bowl America Fairfax, rolled games of 237-209-268 for a 714 series, his second seven in league play. Last year Michaelson also hit the 700 mark with 253-230-235, a pretty 718, in the Tuesday Night Men's Handicap, also at Fairfax, and only the fourth seven in the house records. Two years ago, the young lefthander poked out a 699 to set the highest junior series in the area. On that occasion his games were 224-216-259. Bob is now a senior at Oakton High School and in his first full season in the adult leagues. He is carrying a 200-plus average in two leagues, the Monday Night Mixed Fives at Fairfax and the Tri-County Men's Handicap League and he's holding a high 180 in the Falls Church Commercial League and the Shirley Classic.



Bob has his eye on a possible pro career in the future but is currently more interested in attending college somewhere in Virginia.
