## Valesquez fires 868 series; recaptures NCABA series record

Charles Valesquez, 23, of Laurel set an NCABA series record Dec. 30 when he scored 299-290-279/868 in the Larry Wolf Men's Continental League at Fair Lanes Laurel.

Valesquez previously had established the NCABA mark on July 31, 1991—the last day of the 1990-91 season—when he rolled an 840 series at Laurel. That score, however, was topped by Mike Whorton's 855 at Bowl America Manassas on Oct. 14.

In the 868, which fell 10 pins short of the Maryland series record held by PBA member Wayne Webb, Valesquez rolled 33 of 36 possible strikes.
