# CRYSTAL SHAW

Crystal Shaw recorded the first 800 series in the 64-year history of the area's Women's Championship Tournament when the slender right-hander scored 807 on games of 263-289-255 in the Singles event March 7 at Bowl America Shirley. She won the Optional Scratch Singles title and placed second in Singles.

As the Director of the Extended Day Aftercare Program at the prestigious Potomac School in McLean, Shaw manages a staff of eight that helps provide a safe and warm atmosphere for students during after-school hours while ensuring proper guidance and homework completion and seeing that rest, play, and exercise are received as needed.

Meanwhile, she takes classes at Northern Virginia Community College towards earning a career-assisting Early Childhood Education Certificate and plans to graduate this summer.
