
Eric Helmrich honored as Chuck Hall Star of Tomorrow

The Chuck Hall and Alberta E. Crowe Star of Tomorrow award winners are selected by USBC in recognition of their distinguished bowling performance, academic achievement, extracurricular activities, and community involvement. Each recipient receives a \$1,500 scholarship, renewable up to three years.
