King defeated Collin Nilsen of East Hartford, Ct., in the championship game, 188-156, to take home the top scholarship prize of \$1,400 (in total, he collected \$1,597). King, who qualified fifth for the stepladder finals, began with a 179-156 victory over Cory Meyers of Aurora, Colo. He then edged Barry Quiel of Roseville, Calif., 223-215, before defeating Glen Phillips of Clifton, N.J., 191-163, to reach the title match.

Ken Drzewiecki of Germantown placed eighth in the handicap division and took home a \$70 scholarship prize.

A total of 175 bowlers (112 scratch, 63 handicap) participated in the event, with more than \$17,000 in scholarship prizes awarded.
