There also was a tie for top honors in the Men's Singles category, with Barry Wallace and Johnson each pocketing \$75 for their 746 series. Ricky Wallace took home \$40 for his third-place 740 series. Other cashers included No. 4, Richard Wolfe (721), \$30; 5, Doug Knoth Jr., Alexandria (712), \$20; and 6, Gregory Turner, Lanham (701), \$10.
