## Cameron, Rhea win BPAA U.S. Open spots

Kendra Cameron of Gambrills, Md., will represent Maryland in the Bowling Proprietors' Association of America Women's U.S. Open in Wichita, Kansas in September as a result of her



victory in the recent state qualifier at Harford Lanes in Aberdeen. Cameron, a Maryland–Baltimore County geography major who hopes to become a professional bowler, qualified second after scoring 989 for five games. She then won all of her games (180-234-204-220) during match play to capture the U.S. Open entry spot (value: \$225) and \$300.

Meanwhile, Melissa Rhea of Alexandria, who led all qualifers with 1,709 for eight games, defeated Lisa Rand (1,680) of Fairfax 265-257 last month at Bowl America Shirley to earn \$400 and the right to represent Virginia in the U.S. Open. Earlier, Rand defeated Susie

Ryan (1,708) of Springfield 245-183. Rand took home \$200; Ryan, \$150. Other cashers: Joanne Harris (1,651) of Occoquan, \$110; and Dawn Fay (1,638) of Manassas, \$85.
