



LARRY O'NEILL'S 791 ASSOCIATION RECORD

On September 6, Larry O'Neill bowled the highest sanctioned series in the history of the Nation's Capital Area Bowling Association.

O'Neill, who holds the association single-season average mark with a 225, rolled games of 223, 289 and 279 for a 791 series. This surpasses the 787 scored by Ken Slack during the 1971-72 season.

O'Neill noted several other top scores in the league and gave credit to the "superb lane conditions" at Shirley Park, which is hosting the prestigious Masters for the first time.
