Rolling in the NOVA All Stars League at Annandale, Larry O'Neill fired games of 290, 300, and 248 to record an 838 series, a new NCABA record.

The many-time top ranked area bowler had a string of 28 consecutive strikes—from the second frame in game one through frame five of the third game—as he once again gave area bowlers a new target to take aim at in the association series department. In 1979 O'Neill scored a 791 in the Virginia Masters at Shirley Park, a record that stood for only a few months until Tony Sutphin rolled the area's first 800 series at McLean.
