O'NEILL WINS MAASBA EVENT AT CROWN

Larry O'Neill won the first MAASBA event for the 1981-82 season at Brunswick Crown Lanes in Baltimore with a winning margin of 176 pins. This event marked the first match play type tournament and after qualifying third, O'Neill averaged a formidable 240 for the eight games match play. He caught the qualifying leader, Steve Sipe, in the second match by defeating Sipe 280-182. Only once thereafter did he relinquish the lead—to Greg Goetz—but he came back to win three straight matches and went into the final position round with a 200-pin lead.

O'Neill pocketed \$410 for his efforts. Runner-up Sipe collected \$205 and Goetz won \$130 for third place. A surprisingly low turnout of only 35 bowlers was the cause for the smallest prize fund in the MAASBA history. A total of eight places were paid, since there were eight qualifiers in the match play format. A complete final standings is shown below.

The next MAASBA event will be November 1st in Fredericksburg, VA and then the MAASBA comes to the Washington area with an event scheduled for November 29th at Ten Pin Coliseum in Alexandria.
