
Jefferson-Lowe duo wins 600-700 Scratch Doubles Tournament at Bethesda Naval Bowling Center

The Temple Hills team of Quintina Jefferson and Keni Lowe Jr. tallied 1,410 and took home the top prize of \$1,100 at the 600-700 Scratch Doubles Tournament held February 26 at the Bethesda Naval Bowling Center. Jefferson rolled a 581 series on games of 159-210-212, and Lowe recorded 300-239-299/829 and received a \$500 U.S. Savings Bond for posting the tournament's first perfecto this season.

Dawn Fay of Manassas and Derek Payne of Alexandria put together a 1,369 total that was good for second place and \$550. They were followed by No. 3, Cheryl Joppy, Hyattville & Greg Turner, Lanham (1,338), \$450; 4, Nicole Mundy, Hyattville & Greg Turner (1,334), \$250; and 5, Terri Franklin, Spotsylvania, Va. & Willmundo Marchanyvalentin, Frederick, Md. (1,329), \$200.

Annie Hunt of Forestville scored 686 and earned \$100 for winning the optional Women's Singles event. Other cashers included No. 2, Dawn Fay (672), \$60; 3, Lianella Teran, Alexandria (671), \$40; 4, Terri Franklin (666), \$20; and 5, Nicole Mundy (662), \$10.

In the optional Men's Singles event, Lowe pocketed an additional \$100 for his 829 series. Others: 2, J.C. Arbogast, Manassas (744), \$60; 3, Bobby Hall, Landover (732), \$30; and 4, Cumberland Parks, Upper Marlboro (711), \$20.
