
REUBEN "RUBE" SCHEIDT FIRES CAREER HIGH 749



Bowling in the Ted Newman Classic League at Bowl America-Shirley, Rube Scheidt put together games of 269-222-258 for his career high series of 749 on November 28, 1975.

Rube's 749 series helped boost his average from 196 to 200 and helped boost his team (Arlington Marine) into the league's first place position. Teammates include: Fred Ridgway, Buck Crouch, Vince Larroque, and Rino Biello.

Bowling since 1954, Rube has held as his highs a 279 game, 720 series, and 203 average [1959-60]. In 1969-70, Rube received 10th in ranking among men bowlers of the city for his 191.

Rube has been on the champion scratch team of both the city and state annual tournaments. In 1968, he and Vince Larroque joined forces at the Cincinnati ABC Tournament and captured 9th place in doubles for their score of 1289. He has had ten series of 700 or more. He bowls in three leagues weekly.

Rube is employed by General Services Administration and is the Arlington Area Manager.
