



TOPS IN THE NATION. Yvonne Tison, 17-year-old senior at Langley High School, leads the nation in the Senior Girls bracket for high series and high game. Yvonne, bowling in the Northern Virginia Scratch Travel League, banged out her top scores during a match at Skor-Mor Lanes. She opened with a normal 170, then exploded her second game for a 246, came right back in the third with a 223, and capped it all with a fourth and final game of 267. Since AJBC rules allow the score to count for either the front three or the last three, Yvonne wound up with a 736 series and a 267 game to take the lead among Senior Girls.

The ironic part about her score is that she had NEVER before rolled a 600. She made her first-ever six in the first three games and went right on for her seven.

Yvonne, who lives in Annandale, says she has been bowling about six years. The pretty righthander carries an average in the 170's. Her highest game before the 267 had been a 248 and her highest set had been 589.
