

# Windsor wins Vir-Mar District 600 Club Tournament of Champions

Top seed Allen Windsor of Woodbridge defeated fourth seed Wayne Artis of



Waldorf 254-214 to win the 16th annual Vir-Mar District 600 Club Tournament of Champions held March 19 at AMF Dale City. Windsor averaged 237.5 for 11 games.

Artis defeated fifth seed Bobby Middleton Jr. of Waldorf 239-214 in the first step-ladder match (which followed a six-game qualifier and four games of match play) and then defeated third seed Alonso Kinney Jr. of the District 226-216 and second seed Eric Helmrich of St. Leonard, Md., 278-268 before losing to Windsor.

The Tournament of Champions awarded \$1,250 in scholarship money to the five finalists: Windsor earned \$500; Artis, \$300; Helmrich, \$200; Kinney, \$150; and Middleton \$100. (See photo on page 23.)
