

NATION'S CAPITAL AREA USBC ASSOCIATION 58th ANNUAL YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT 2022 TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. All USBC Youth Tournament Rules and Requirements will govern this Tournament.

 This tournament is certified through USBC under certification # 07192; Bumper Singles Event is certified under certification # 07237.
- 2. The tournament is open to all USBC Youth members participating in a USBC Youth certified league located within the jurisdictional boundaries of the Nation's Capital Area USBC Association (NCAUSBCA). *Bumper Singles participants must be a certified bowler in a bumper league within NCAUSBCA. Bowler memberships must be current for the 2021-2022 season.

3. DRESS CODE -

- Shirts
- All Shirts must have a butterfly collar or mock collar.
 - Mock collar must be a minimum of 3/4 of one inch.
- All shirts must have finished sleeves for all competition.
- . Bowlers may wear their USBC Youth Jersey or League issued uniform shirt.
- No cotton t-shirts, sweatshirts, shirts with sleeves cut off, torn or ripped may be worn.
- No writing on or defacing of the bowling shirt will be permitted.
- Pants
- All bowlers must wear full-length pants/slacks, jeans, shorts (no more than 3 inches above the knees), skorts, skirts (no
 more than 3 inches above the knees) or Capri pants during all levels of competition.
- No athletic shorts will be allowed.
- No jeans with holes, bib overalls, scooters, warm-up suits or clothes with elastic at the ankles.
- Other
- All apparel shall be loose fitting and not made of fleece or Lycra/spandex-like material.
- No head covering (hats, caps, bandannas, etc.) or sunglasses may be worn during competition.
- Headphones cannot be used in the settee area and cannot be used during bowling.

The Tournament Management must approve any/all exceptions prior to the event. All decisions of the Tournament Management will be final. *Bumper bowlers are exempt from this dress code.

4. Entering Averages -

- Entrants will use their highest league average as of Dec. 13, 2021, with a minimum of 12 games bowled. (includes games bowled on Dec. 13th)
 * Standing sheets should have already been submitted for this date through the Invitational Tournament.
- II. Those that do not have 12 games by December 13, 2021, then the highest current league average as of February 13, 2022, based on a minimum of 12 games, will be used. (Includes games bowled on February 12, 2022)
 A standing sheet must be brought to the tournament site on the day the bowler is scheduled to bowl.
- III. Those without 12 games bowled by February 13, 2022, then the highest 2020-2021 Book Average will be accepted, to include 2021 Summer
- averages from bowl.com.

 IV. If none of the preceding apply, a tournament average of 200 will be assigned. Exception: Bumper bowlers will be assigned an average of 100.
 - 4A. Sport and Challenge averages will be adjusted per USBC Rule # 201c using the Sport or Challenge Average Adjustment Scales.
 4B. Falsification of average will result in disgualification of the bowler.
- 5. This is a Handicap tournament; the allowance shall be 100% and is figured on the difference between each individual's average and 230 scratch (100% of 230). Exception: Bumper Division shall use 100% of 120.
- 6. Team Event will consist of 4 bowlers on a team, regardless of age or gender, and division is determined by team average. Doubles Event will consist of 2 bowlers, regardless of age or gender, and division is determined by doubles team average. Singles Event, Handicap & Scratch All Events, Scratch Singles and Bumper Singles Event divisions will be determined by individual average.
- 7. The tournament will be divided into the following divisions:

- 8. Bowlers will bowl 3 games in each of the following events: Team, Doubles, and Singles. Bumper Singles bowlers will bowl 2 games.
 *Singles and Doubles events will be bowled during the same squad -- Singles will be bowled first, followed by Doubles, for a total of 6 consecutive games.
- 9. Bowlers MUST enter both Singles and Doubles to be able to bowl in either one. Singles and Doubles entrants are not required to bowl in the Team Event. Team entrants are not required to bowl in the Singles and Doubles event. Bowlers must enter Team, Singles & Doubles to qualify for All Events.
- 10. Bowlers may participate in the Team Event multiple times, provided that no more than 2 bowlers remain the same. The *highest* Team Event scores bowled will be applied toward the individual's All Events. Bowlers may participate in the Doubles Event (one bowler must be different) and Singles Event multiple times. The *highest* Doubles & Singles events scores bowled will be applied toward the individual's All Events. The *highest* Singles Event scores bowled will be used toward Singles division award placement. A bowler may only place once in the Singles Event. Bumper bowlers may enter Bumper Singles Event more than once.
- 11. Team and Doubles events will bowl in the bowler order listed on the original entry form. Substitutes will be permitted only in the same line-up position. Should the average of the substitute bowler change the division of an entry, the entry division will be reclassified automatically. No changes will be made except by the Tournament Committee.
- 12. Handicap All Events: This is an optional event, and to be entered into Handicap All Events, bowlers must register and pay the required fee of \$5. Bowlers may enter the Handicap All Events only once, even if they participate in multiple Team, Doubles & Singles events. The scores of the *highest* event of Team, Doubles and Singles bowled will be used toward the Handicap All Events.
- 13. Scratch All Events: This is an optional event, and to be entered into Scratch All Events, bowlers must register and pay the required fee of \$10. Bowlers may enter the Scratch All Events only once, even if they participate in multiple Team, Doubles & Singles events. The scores of the *highest* event of Team, Doubles, and Singles bowled will be used toward the Scratch All Events.

Rules Continued

- 14. Scratch Singles Add-on: This is an optional event, and to be entered into the Scratch Singles event, bowlers must register and pay the required fee of \$10. Bowlers may enter the Scratch Singles add-on more than once, provided that they participate in multiple Doubles & Singles events. The scratch scores of the bowled Singles event will be used toward the Scratch Singles add-on.
- 15. No open bowling will be allowed on assigned lanes within 1 hour prior to assigned squad time.
- 16. Bowlers must report to the tournament office at least 30 minutes prior to assigned squad times. Bowlers must present their USBC Youth Membership cards at check-in if asked for by a Tournament Official. If any substitutions are to be made, the Team Captain or Coach must report to the tournament office at least one hour prior to the scheduled squad time. Once a substitute has been entered and tournament competition has started, that substitute will not be removed should the original bowler arrive.
- 17. Entry fees shall be as follows:

Team, Doubles, and Singles events: \$20.00 per bowler/per event.

Lineage: \$10.35, Scholarship: \$6.15, Expenses: \$3.00, Scholarship Fund: \$.50 (Blake Harrison)

Handicap All Events: \$5.00 per bowler.

Scholarship: \$4.00, Expenses: \$1.00.

Scratch All Events and Scratch Singles add-on: \$10.00 per bowler.

Scholarship: \$9.00, Expenses: \$1.00.

Bumper Singles event: \$10.00 per bowler.

Lineage: \$6.90, Scholarship: \$1.60, Expenses: \$1.00, Scholarship Fund: \$.50 (Blake Harrison)

- 18. Late bowlers shall receive a zero (0) score for any frames missed. This applies during a game as well as at the beginning of the competition.
- 19. Scholarships will be awarded for at least 1 in every 7 entrants in each event, each division. 100% of all prize money collected in an event or division of an event will be awarded to the participants in that event or division of that event. An additional \$5 per entry for Team event, Doubles event and Singles event will be added to the prize fund from the SMART account. In case of a tie for an award, duplicate awards will be presented. All scholarships will be held by SMART, account # 9559.
 - a) Guaranteed 1st place payout per bowler in handicap Team, Doubles and Singles events \$250.
 - b) Guaranteed 1st place payout in Bumper event \$100.
- 20. Protests regarding a claim, controversy, or violation in a tournament involving any USBC or tournament rule must be filed with the Tournament Director with copies to the local association and USBC Headquarters within 72 hours. Any appeal or protest regarding errors in scoring must be made in writing to the Tournament Director within 24 hours after the error has occurred.
- 21. Entry fees may be paid by personal check, money order, cashier's check, or PayPal (frelke@verizon.net via Friends/Family transaction only)
- 22. This tournament is a No-Smoking / No-Alcohol competition. Youth bowlers participating in this tournament shall not take part in these activities prior to, during, or after the tournament squad times nor inside and outside of the bowling center. *This does include the use of ecigarettes and vaporizers. Those found participating in these activities will be disqualified.
- 23. The White copy of the recap sheet must be turned into the tournament office upon competition of scores being rolled. The recap sheet will be the official score record. Any missing scores will be entered as zero, and any falsified scores will be disqualified.
- 24. All entries must be postmarked no later than **FEBRUARY 10, 2022**. No entry will be accepted without payment of the complete entry fee. **No refunds** of entry fees will be made after the entry has been processed and squad times have been assigned, except in the case of emergencies, inclement weather, and other reasons as determined refundable by the Tournament Committee.
- 25. An Adult League Representative or Coach is responsible for verification of averages and USBC memberships for the current season and <u>MUST</u> complete and sign the entry form.
