

Simpson wins 600 Club Fall Singles Tournament

October 16, 2011 - Michael Simpson of Dale City, Va., bowled a three-game series of 722 to win the NCAUSBCA Youth 600 Club Fall Singles Tournament held this afternoon at Bowl America Shirley. Simpson earned \$110 in scholarship funds, which will be administered through the USBC SMART program.

Kayla Meadows of Springfield, Va., bowled a 697 series to capture second-place honors and earn a \$80 scholarship. Cameron Brooks of Bowie, Md., bowled a 686 series for third place and earned a \$60 scholarship. Nick Dean of Alexandria, Va., bowled a 672 series for fourth place and earned a \$40 scholarship. Austin Fosmire of Gainesville, Va., bowled a 663 series for fifth place and earned a \$30 scholarship.

All five bowlers qualified for the Tournament of Champions, which will be held on March 25. In addition, Lamont Pearson Jr. of Bryans Road, Md. (650 series) and Jason Eman of Springfield (638) also qualified for the Tournament of Champions.

The next two 600 Club tournaments will be a doubles event on November 20 at AMF Waldorf and a singles event on December 11 at Bowl America Burke.
