#### **FORMAT**

Five games will be bowled across ten lanes. Top eight bowlers in each division will participate in a single elimination match play to determine the winners.

There must be at least 16 bowlers in a division in order to run that division. All bowlers must check in at least 30 minutes prior to start time. After each game, bowlers will move one pair to the right. If you reach the end of available lanes, you will go to the far end of available lanes to continue. Late bowlers will receive a zero for all frames missed. A frame will be considered missed when a bowler is not at his/her assigned lane ready to bowl. All scores will be recorded on the recap sheet provided and verified by another bowler. After your final game of qualifying, you will complete your score sheet and turn it in to a tournament official. Each bowler must sign his/her score sheet. Only bowlers and officials are allowed in the settee area.

YOU ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A COLLARED SHIRT TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS TOURNAMENT. ANY UNRULY BEHAVIOR FROM BOWLERS OR SPECTATORS CAN CAUSE THE BOWLER TO BE DISQUALIFIED AND EXPELLED FROM THE BOWLING CENTER FOR THE DURATION OF THE TOURNAMENT.

## **Rules and Regulations**

USBC tournament rules and regulations will apply for this event. You must be a USBC member. THIS EVENT IS USBC CERTIFIED. Non-USBC members can purchase the USBC Youth Associate membership for \$17.00 at the tournament. There will be 2 divisions: 1 handicap and 1 scratch. Each bowler must select the division in which they desire to bowl. Handicap will be 90% of 210. Entries close at 09:45 AM the day of the tournament. Bowlers will use their highest NCAUSBCA 2011-2012 book average. If you do not bowl in NCAUSBCA and your organization has a year book for averages, you can present that to verify your bowler's average. If you do not have a book average then your highest current league average of 21 games or more must be used. The latest league standing sheet must be available at the time of registration. If you do not have a league sheet or book average, vou will bowl scratch. BOWLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR VERIFYING HIS/HER OWN AVERAGE, WHETHER SUBMITTED BY THE BOWLER, THE COACH, OR OTHER LEAGUE OFFICIAL. IF THE SUBMITTED AVERAGE IS LOWER THAN THE ACTUAL AVERAGED AND RESULTS IN A LOWER CLASSIFICATION OR MORE HANDICAP, THE BOWLER'S SCORE IS DISOUALIFIED. IF THE SUBMITTED AVERAGE IS HIGHER THAN REQUIRED, PRIZE WINNINGS WILL BE BASED ON THE SUBMITTED **AVERAGE.** Corrections in averages may be permitted up to the completion of the first game.

Score corrections during the tournament must be made by a tournament official.

- Awards will be in the form of scholarship dollars. The scholarships awarded will be administered by SMART. The SMART Account Number is 2046.
- 2. Ties will be decided by a ninth and tenth frame roll off. In the Handicap division, the bowler's scratch score plus two frame handicap will be used to determine the placement for match play. In the Scratch division, the bowler's scratch scores bowled will determine the placement for match play. 1st place ties in match play will be determined by a 1 game roll off. If there is still a tie after the one game roll off, then a ninth and tenth frame roll off will be held until a winner is determined.
- 3. Award fees will be returned 100%.
- 4. The USBC rulebook will cover any rules not addressed in these tournament rules.
